Other 25 students and professionals from 13 Caribbean islands were awarded

San Juan, Puerto Rico (July 12, 2007) – The Caribbean Hotel Association Education Foundation (CHAEF) awarded 26 academic scholarship totalling US\$86,500 to promising Caribbean students and industry professionals from 13 Caribbean islands. The Virgin Holidays Tourism Management Scholarship was granted to Shelly-Ann Zena Stanislaus, as presented by Mr. John Taker, Purchasing Director of Virgin Holidays during the recent Caribbean Hotel and Tourism Conference in Miami.

The Virgin Holidays Tourism Management Scholarship offers a deserving student from the Caribbean an award of US \$10,000 per year, for three years, to pursue studies related to the tourism industry. For Shelly-Ann, who works at the Sandals Regency Golf Resort & Spa, in Castries, St. Lucia, the recognition tips the balance in favor of her goal to enroll at the prestigious Johnson & Wales University, to obtain a Bachelor of Science degree in Hospitality Management.
