<sup>1</sup> The rate of US\$1.78 per 1,000 litres (US\$8.09 per 1,000 gallons) applies to usage only and relates to commercial customers. There are other components to the water bill:

- a) The Sewerage Charge which is equal to 100 per cent of the water usage charge.
- b) The monthly Service Charge which varies according to the size of the meter or service connection. The charges range between US\$3.79 monthly for a 5/8 inch/15 mm service connection and US\$ 121.13 monthly for a 6 in/150 mm service connection. The vast majority of domestic customers use a 5/8 inch service connection.
- c) The Price Adjustment Mechanism (PAM) which is the approved formula by which changes in variable costs associated with the Foreign Exchange Rate and Electricity Rates are reflected on the bill as monthly adjustments. The PAM applies to all components of the bill
