¹ Active Member = The individual representative who is designated by an Active Hotel Member as its representative to CHTA. Any individual who is designated as an Active Member shall be engaged on a full time basis on an executive level in the operations of the Active Hotel Member which designated such individual.

² Association Member = Any association of Hotels in the Region recognized as such by CHTA and which agrees to collect on behalf of and to forward to CHTA dues from such Association's Active Hotel Members.

³ A signed proxy form allows the designee to vote on any matter which arises at the AGM, in addition to casting their own vote. The Bylaws stipulate that no more than one Proxy may be held by any eligible member. The member assigning the proxy also reserves the right to designate on the proxy form whether the proxy holder is limited in their representation of the member to a particular vote or is relegated the power of representation and voting for all matters arising at the AGM.
