










#### Year to date arrivals to world regions \*

### Widespread declines across Caribbean destinations








#### Year to date arrivals to Caribbean\*

1 January to 21 June 2020; Year-on-Year variations by region








### **Dramatic decline in seat capacity to the Caribbean**








#### China domestic air travel ticketing trend

1 January to 7 June 2020 vs 1 January to 8 June 2019



















### Weekly ticket distribution made for future travel to Antigua & Barbuda, Jamaica and Martinique

2020 vs 2019 booking volumes





#### Weekly tickets made for future travel to Caribbean and US Virgin Islands from U.S.A










#### Weekly tickets made for Intra-Caribbean travel

2020 vs 2019 booking volumes




### Travellers appetite for travel to the Caribbean shifts from Q3 to Q4



### Cuba and the Dominican Republic are the most searched destination from U.S.A, Canada and the UK for Q1 2021










### Long haul bookings for Q4 peak in September







#### Long haul flight bookings to the LATAM for travel in October, November and December




### Lead times for top long-haul source markets to Caribbean







### **Average Lead times\* for Long Haul travel to Caribbean** (average 110 days)













#### New reported cases by day in Florida




Rising cases in primary source markets create an immense challenge in reaching a suitable equilibrium to bring our tourism economy back online

## Passenger numbers: 2019/2020 baselines versus COVID-19 adjusted projections (Latin America/Caribbean)




